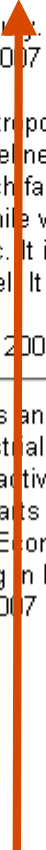

A Canal to Res

The Dead Sea's shores are being devastated by the slow asphyxia of the sea. It has lost one third of its surface over the past forty years, and its level drops one meter a year. The **dynamic flow in** the underground **water table** is disturbed, **causing** ground collapses, **resulting in** more than hundreds holes around the shores. The landscape has changed. A deep salty and muddy area replaces water everywhere it has moved back. About ten kilometres further, the causes of this asphyxia are visible on the Jordan River banks. Of the Jordan River, the border between Jordan and Israel, there does not remain much: a tiny muddy dark green stream, nearly still water.
